Program Description

The Kitchen Aide will enhance the dignity and quality of life for each resident by supporting holistic wellness and an interdependent community. In collaboration with the Head Chef and Sous Chef, the Kitchen Aide would provide support to individuals in areas of well-being by cooking meals, serving residents and cleaning the kitchen.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Adhere to Accessible Housing policies, procedures, guidelines, rules, regulations and schedules
- Be responsible as a team member to ensure a high standard of service is provided for our Residents
- Maintain positive relations with Residents, Administration and other staff members
- Ensure menu preparation adheres to all food safe handling preparations
- Assist in serving meals
- Be responsible for reporting any areas of concern, safety or maintenance to the Head Chef
- Be responsible for reporting shortages or items requiring re-ordering to the Head Chef
- Ensure proper storage and disposal of all food products
- Be responsible for the general organization and cleanliness of food service areas and dining rooms during shift
- Attend staff meeting and in-services as required
- Carry out other duties as may be assigned from time to time

Qualifications

- Must possess a minimum Grade 12 Education or equivalent
- One year related commercial kitchen experience in a related environment is preferred
- Food Safe Handlers Course would be desirable
- Understanding of WHMIS is required
- Must have a high standard of hygiene and a clean and professional personal appearance
- Must be flexible and have a positive attitude
- Dependable and trustworthy
- Good organizational and interpersonal skills

Working Conditions

- Must be able to withstand a variety of temperature conditions
- Good physical condition with no history of back problems (A medical may be required)

Physical Requirements

- This position may require lifting of up to 50lbs
- Bend, twist, squat, standing or reaching on a consistent basis
